This is the cookie policy of Clasital which applies to the use of Clasital Platform ("**Cookie Policy**"). Please read this Cookie Policy carefully alongside with, and in addition to, our Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, terms used have the same meaning as in our Terms and Conditions.

We use cookies to enhance your experience at the Clasital Platform and the Courses and to better understand how people use it. This may also include cookies from third party social media websites. You can change your cookies settings at any time by following the instructions below in paragraph 3: "How to Manage Cookies".

1. What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- A. <u>Strictly Necessary Cookies</u>: These cookies are required for the operation of the Clasital Platform and they are strictly necessary to provide you with services available through our website.
- B. <u>Functionality Cookies</u>: These cookies are managed by our service provides to enhance the performance and functionality of the Clasital Platform. These cookies are non-essential however, without them, certain functionality may become unavailable.
- C. <u>Statistics Cookies</u>: These cookies collect information about how you use a website, like which pages you visited, and which links you clicked on. None of this information can be used to identify you. It is all aggregated and, therefore, anonymized. Their sole purpose is to improve website functions. This includes cookies from third-party analytics services as long as the cookies are for the exclusive use of the owner of the website visited.

2. Types of Cookies

clasital_jwt	A cookie which is essential for our site to identify you as a specific user and authorize you when you want to log into secure areas of the Clasital Platform and prevents unauthorized parties from accessing your accounts.

stripe_mid	A token set by Stripe (payment provider) to enable us to facilitate the payment of the Courses.	

stripe_sid	A token set by Stripe (payment provider) to enable us to facilitate the payment of the Courses.
zlcmid	A cookie managed by Zendesk (service provider) to enable us to provide our live chat service.

C. Statistics Cookies

Cookie Name	Purpose
'GTM-TVLPJBL'	This is a Google Analytics 4 service which enables us to measure traffic and engagement across Clasital Platform.
_hjFirstSeen	This is a Hotjar cookie that tells us if this is the first time you've visited the site.
_hjid	This is a Hotjar cookie that's set when the user first lands on a page with the Hotjar script. It creates a unique ID for your session to help tell us how you use our site.
_hjIncludedInPageviewSampl	This cookie lets Hotjar know if you're part of a group of users we're sampling for information about how the site is being used. It expires after 30 minutes.
_hjSession_2912897	This is a Hotjar cookie that holds the current session data. This makes sure that subsequent requests within the session window will be attributed to the same Hotjar session.
_hjSessionUser_2912897	This is a Hotjar cookie that's set when a user first lands on a page with the Hotjar script. It's used to persist the Hotjar User ID, unique to that site on the browser. This ensures that behavior in subsequent visits to the same site will be attributed to the same user ID.
